Please review the following applications and advise us whether you have any national security, law enforcement, foreign policy or trade concerns by C.O.B. May 16, 2007, because we are prepared to take action on these applications. **Electronic filed (e-file) applications are able to be viewed by accessing www.fcc.gov/ibfs and searching by the file number.**

ITC-214-20070423-00154(e-file)

Netvox Corp.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Venezuela**.

ITC-214-20070418-00153(e-file)

Reach Ltd.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services on the U.S. – **Kiribati** route. Applicant is incorporated in **Bermuda**, and is a joint venture owned in equal parts by Telstra Holdings (Bermuda) No. 1 Limited, a **Bermuda** corporation, and Pacific Century Cable Holdings Limited, a **Bermuda** company. Applicant requests that the Commission **condition** this authorization on compliance with the terms of Agreement between the applicant and the Executive Branch, effective November 29, 2001, as amended. (See fn1 of the application).

Cascabel Networks LLC's application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 50% owned by a citizen of **Mexico**.

ITC-T/C-20070425-00162(e-file)

Application for consent to transfer control of section 214 authorization, ITC-214-20020306-00105, held by Comsat International, Inc. from COMSAT International Holdings, LLC to British Telecommunications plc. Applicant, British Telecommunications plc, will be a controlling party of Comsat International, Inc. BT is incorporated and located in **London, England**. Further, applicant agrees to continue to be classified as a **dominant carrier on the U.S. -J.K. route**.

ITC-STA-20070424-00158 (e-file)

Application for consent to transfer control of section 214 authorization, ITC-214-20010806-0414, held by IDL Corp. from DecisionLink, Inc. (DLNK) to MO2, Inc. A Swiss corporation holds 48.29% in MO2, Inc. On March 12, 2004, **without prior Commission approval**, all the stock of the licensee, IDL corp., was transferred from DLNK to a corporation owned by its creditors, MO2 (identified as NEWCO in the Plan of Reorganization).

Concurrent with this application, the parties also seek a Special Temporary Authority (STA), **ITC-STA-20070424-00158**, to transfer control of IDL corp. to MO2. Since the applicants acknowledge that the grant of STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application, and that the Commission may revoke upon its own motion without a hearing, we are prepared to grant the STA to the applicants, if you do not oppose.

If we do not hear from you by **C.O.B. May 16, 2007**, we will assume that you do not have any concerns with the above listed applications.

ISP-PDR-20070119-0007

Able Infosat Communications, Inc. (Able Infosat or the "Petitioner") requests that the Commission find permissible its indirect foreign ownership in excess of the 25 percent benchmark set forth in Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4). Able Infosat holds a Commercial Mobile Radio Service license and filed its petition in connection with an application for consent to an unauthorized pro forma transfer of control. See ULS File No. 0002865620. Able Infosat has not previously disclosed its indirect foreign ownership to the Commission or sought the required ruling under Section 310(b)(4).

Able Infosat, a U.S. corporation, is wholly owned by Infosat Able Holdings, Inc., a U.S.-organized holding company. Infosat Able Holdings, Inc. is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Infosat Communications, Inc. (Infosat Canada), a Canadian corporation. Infosat Canada is wholly owned by Telesat Canada, which, in turn, is wholly owned by BCE Inc. Telesat Canada and BCE Inc. are both organized in Canada.

Petitioner asserts that, pursuant to the rules and policies established in the Commission's *Foreign Participation Order*, 12 FCC Rcd 23891 (1997), *Order on Reconsideration*, 15 FCC Rcd 18158 (2000), the indirect foreign ownership of Able Infosat in excess of 25% is consistent with the public interest.

The previously undisclosed foreign ownership of the petitioner was discovered during due diligence in preparation for filing the applications to transfer control of Able Infosat and affiliated companies. See ISP-PDR-20070130-00002, which is still under your review. (We have received your letter of April 6, 2007 to defer action on the Telesat/Loral/BCE/ Holdco applications.) **Please comment on this request by May 11, 2007.**
