Ms. Sutton:

As requested, this letter addresses the questions you had earlier regarding Converge Telecom Group Inc.'s ("Converge's" or "Company's") customers, and whether customer notifications were required before the Company ceased providing telecommunications services. Converge was a provider of international prepaid calling card services and ceased operations in March 2010. At the time it ceased operations, Converge did not have any active prepaid calling cards in the market (*i.e.*, balances on all previously distributed cards had been consumed or expired). Thus, the Company did not have any customers to notify. Accordingly, Converge requests that its international Section 214 Authorization be cancelled.¹
