
Horizon Mobile Communications, Inc. ("HMC"), by counsel, hereby surrenders its International Section 214 Authority allowing it to provide Inmarsat Broadband Global Area Network Mobile-Satellite Service ("MSS") as a facilities-based and resale provider (FCC File No. ITC-214-20070110-00021, granted January 30, 2009). No prior notice of discontinuance is required under Section 63.19 of the Commission's Rules, as the MSS offering covered is categorized as a commercial mobile radio service under Section 20.9(a)(10) of the Rules. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 63.19(c). In any case, HMC currently has no active customers, and therefore no end users could potentially be disadvantaged by this license surrender. Moreover, HMC is in the process of winding down its operations and does not anticipate providing any telecommunications services in the future utilizing the subject authorization. Accordingly, HMC formally requests cancellation of its International Section 214 authorization.
