Dear Sirs,

The Department of Justice (DoJ), including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, with the concurrence of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (collectively, the “Agencies”) requested that the FCC terminate, declare null and void and no longer in effect, the current authorization issued under file number **ITC-214-20070601-00211** to Wypoint Telecom, Inc. (“Wypoint”)¹ (certification holder name changed from VOIP Solutions, Inc. (“Sage”) to Wypoint)).² The Agencies allege that Wypoint has failed to comply with commitments and undertakings made with the Agencies by Sage, and compliance with which are a condition to the authorization issued to Sage by the Commission.³ The Agencies further state that they have been unable to communicate with Wypoint for over a year in an effort to resolve this matter.

The International Bureau previously afforded Wypoint an opportunity to respond to the Agencies’ letter by a letter dated May 14, 2014⁴ and also a Public Notice issued on June 27,



2014.⁵ To date, Wypoint has failed to respond. Attached is a copy of a second Public Notice issued by the International Bureau providing Wypoint a final opportunity to respond prior to Commission action on the Agencies' request.⁶ The Public Notice will be published in the Federal Register. Wypoint must respond to the Public Notice no later than 15 days after publication in the Federal Register.
