NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Dear Mr. Dias:

On October 8, 2008, we requested by official correspondence, also forwarded to you by e-mail, information about the status of your application referenced above. You were advised that the Commission's rules provide that failure to respond to information requests would subject the application to dismissal without prejudice. We are hereby dismissing your application in view of your failure to respond as of this date.

On August 24, 2007, the Commission notified you that the PhoneBrasil International, Inc. application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review<sup>2</sup> and that the Executive Branch would contact you for additional information.<sup>3</sup> On July 23, 2008, the Commission requested PhoneBrasil notify the Commission the status of Executive Branch review of its application and confirm whether the applicant continues to seek Commission action on the application.<sup>4</sup> On July 23, 2008, the Commission received a response stating that PhoneBrasil wished to seek Commission action on the application and the applicant would contact the Executive Branch agencies.<sup>5</sup> Our October 8, 2008 correspondence requested the applicant notify the Commission no later than October 22, 2008 the status of their application in the Executive Branch review and, in particular, confirmation that the applicant has made contact with the Executive Branch and the date of that contact.<sup>6</sup> The Executive Branch agencies, with whom we coordinate, have confirmed that they have not been contacted by PhoneBrasil. To date, you have failed to respond to the Commission's October 8, 2008 correspondence.
