ITC-214-20070724-00291(e-file)
Interconnect, Inc.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 50% owned by a citizen of **Russia** and 50% owned by a citizen of **Russia and Greece**.

ITC-214-20070717-00297(e-file)
USA Communication, Inc.'s application for authority to provide resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Mexico**.

ITC-214-20070730-00307(e-file)
PhoneBrasil International Inc.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Brazil**.

Providence Equity Partners VI International L.P. (U.S. firm) holds a 25.99% direct voting interest and a 22% direct economic interest in the Transferee. Morcagu Holdings Corp. (**Canadian** corporation) holds a 66.67% direct voting interest and a nominal economic interest in the Transfer.

Dear Mr. Pombo:

On November 4, 2010, we requested by official correspondence, also forwarded to you by e-mail, information about the status of your application referenced above.¹ You were advised that the Commission's rules provide that failure to respond to information requests would subject the application to dismissal without prejudice.

On August 24, 2007, the Commission notified you that the Sipcom Corporation application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review² and that the Executive Branch would contact you for addition information.³ On October 12, 2010, the Commission requested Sipcom Corporation notify the Commission the status of Executive Branch review of its application and confirm whether the applicant continues to seek Commission action on the application.⁴ Our November 4, 2010 correspondence requested the applicant notify the Commission no later than November 18, 2010 the status of their application in the Executive Branch review and, in particular, confirmation that the applicant has made contact with the Executive Branch and the date of that contact.⁵ The Executive Branch agencies, with whom we coordinate, have confirmed that they have not been contacted by Espinal Technologies Group USA, Inc. To date, you have failed to respond to both the Commission's October 12, 2010 and November 4, 2010 correspondence.
