**ITC-214-20070724-00291(e-file)**

Interconnect, Inc.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 50% owned by a citizen of **Russia** and 50% owned by a citizen of **Russia and Greece**.

**ITC-214-20070717-00297(e-file)**

USA Communication, Inc.'s application for authority to provide resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Mexico**.

**ITC-214-20070730-00307(e-file)**

PhoneBrasil International Inc.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 100% owned by a citizen of **Brazil**.

**ITC-214-20070801-00311(e-file)**

Sipcom Corp.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Two citizens of **Colombia**, each of whom owns 60% and 40% of the applicant, respectively.

Application for consent to transfer control of international section 214 authorization, ITC-214-19981222-00884, held by BCE Nexxia Voice Services Corporation, from BCE Inc. to **6796508 Canada Inc.** (Transferee).  
Transferee is a **Canadian** corporation. Teachers Private Capital, a division of Ontario Teacher's Pension Plan Board (a **Canadian** pension plan), holds a 51.6% direct economic interest in the Transferee. Providence Equity Partners VI International L.P. (U.S. firm) holds a 25.99% direct voting interest and a 22% direct economic interest in the Transferee. Morcagu Holdings Corp. (**Canadian** corporation) holds a 66.67% direct voting interest and a nominal economic interest in the Transfer.
