Application for authority to land and operate a non-common carrier high capacity fiber-optic submarine cable system linking Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand Brunei, Darussalam, Vietnam, Hong Kong SAR, Philippines and the United States. The AAG system will be owned by AAG Consortium. The ten parties with greater than 5% ownership interest are: AT&T Corp.; Bharti Airtel Limited; CAT Telecom Public Company Limited; Datastream Technology Sdn Bhd, Telekom Brunei Berhad, and the Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang-Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam represented by the Ministry of Communications; Philippine Long Distance Telephone Company; PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia, Tbk.; StarHub Ltd.; Telekom Malaysia Berhad; Telstra Coproration Limited; and Vietnam Posts and Telecommunications Group.
