Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Freedom Telecommunications, Inc., ("Freedom"), this letter surrenders, effective as of the date of this letter, the International Section 214 Authorization of Freedom granted in IB File No. ITC-214-20070928-00394 (Granted: DA 07-4377, October 19, 2007) (the "International 214 Authority").

Freedom is a dark fiber provider in California and has never provided international telecommunications services - or any telecommunications services at all, for that matter. Freedom does not foresee ever offering regulated international services and thus has no need for the International 214 Authority. Because Freedom has never served any customers or have any active telecommunications operations (nor has it ever had any telecommunications customers), Freedom respectfully submits that the surrender of its International 214 Authority is reasonable and necessary and will not be disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity.
