Modern Gate Telecom LLC's application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 75% owned by a citizen of **Jordan**.

Ekofon, Inc.'s application for authority to provide resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Three citizens of **Mexico**, each of whom owns 34%, 33% and 33% of the applicant, respectively.

ITC-214-20071023-00433 (e-file)

Onchannel Communications, Corp.'s application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Two citizens of **Colombia**, each of whom owns 50% of the applicant.
