Dear Mr. Al-Hindi:

Our records indicate that your international section 214 application (File No. ITC-214-20071019-00425) remains pending at the Commission awaiting completion of review by the Executive Branch. We forwarded the application to the Executive Branch agencies on October 26, 2007. On November 16, 2007, the Commission notified you that your application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review.<sup>1</sup>

We understand that you have been contacted by the Executive Branch requesting information about your application and you should have provided to them all necessary and requested information. On October 12, 2010, the Commission requested Modern Gate Telecom, LLC notify the Commission the status of the pending application and confirm whether the applicant continues to seek Commission action on the application.<sup>2</sup> Your legal counsel responded stating they have been unable to reach you.<sup>3</sup> We have been informed that Team Telecom has not received any follow-up response from multiple attempts at contacting you.<sup>4</sup>

Please inform us no later than April 7, 2011, of the status of the application in the Executive Branch review process and, in particular, confirm that you have made contact with the Executive Branch and the date of that contact.
