**ITC-214-20080528-00244 (e-file)**

ITC International Telecommunications Corp.'s application for authority to provide facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 20% owned by a citizen of the **United Kingdom**.

**SCL-LIC-20080516-00010 (e-file)**

An application for a license to construct, land, and operate a non-common carrier fiber optic submarine cable extending between the United States and Japan. This cable system will be called the **Unity Cable System (Unity)**. Unity will be 40% owned by Pacnet Services (USA) Inc. and 20% owned by GU Holdings Inc. Bharti Airtel Limited, KDDI Corporation, Singapore Telecommunications Limited and Global Transit Limited, each of whom will own 10% of the Unity. Counsel indicates that copies of the application will be sent to Team Telecom.

If we do not hear from you by **C.O.B. June 18, 2008**, we will assume that you do not have any concerns with the above listed applications.
