**SECOND SUPPLEMENT TO JOINT APPLICATION TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF
DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATIONS**

In support of the above referenced application of Lightbound, LLC (“Lightbound” or “Transferor”) and DataBank Holdings Ltd. (“DataBank” or “Transferee”), the following further additional information is provided regarding the request for Commission consent to the transfer control of the domestic and international Section 214 authorizations of Lightbound’s wholly-owned subsidiary, HRS Internet, LLC (“HRS Internet”) (together with Lightbound and DataBank, “Applicants”) from Lightbound to DataBank.

The Applicants herein confirm that HRS Internet and Lightbound are Indiana limited liability companies.

As indicated in the Applicants’ response to Question 11, four entities have indirect equity interests of 10 percent or more in Data Bridge Holdings, LLC (“Data Bridge”), which is the ultimate parent company of DataBank. These four entities are the Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association of America (“TIAA”), The Allstate Corporation, Edgewater Funds and CBRE

Caledon Capital Management Inc. In this second supplement, the Applicants herein confirm that no party holds a direct or indirect equity interest of 10 percent or more in TIAA or The Allstate Corporation.
