This firm represents Dumont Telephone Company, an Iowa corporation ("Dumont") and its wholly-owned subsidiary, Universal Communications of Allison, Inc., an Iowa corporation ("Universal"). The FCC granted Dumont international Section 214 authority to provide global or limited global resale service, file number ITC-214-20080707-00305. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 63.21(h), Dumont provided notice to the FCC by letter filed October 28, 2008 that Universal would provide global or limited global resale service under Dumont's section 214 authority.

Universal is planning to dissolve, effective December 31, 2009. Upon dissolution, Universal's operations will be transferred to Dumont, its parent company. Dumont is hereby providing notice to the FCC that, effective December 31, 2009, Universal will no longer be providing global or limited global resale service under Dumont's section 214 authority. Dumont will begin providing service to Universal's subscribers immediately upon termination of service by Universal, so there will be no discontinuance of service.
