Philips A. Falcone, a US citizen, has 100% voting interest in Harbinger.

TerreStar License is affiliated with a foreign carrier, TerreStar Networks (Canada) Inc. ("TerreStar Canada"). TerreStar Canada has two shareholders: TerreStar Networks Holdings (Canada) Inc. ("TerreStar Canada Holdings") which has an 80 percent ownership interest, and TerreStar, which has a 20 percent ownership interest. In total 4491165 Canada Inc. has a 53-1/3 percent interest in TerreStar Canada and TerreStar has a 46-2/3 percent ownership interest in TerreStar Canada.
