Re: Request to Withdraw 214 Application, ITC-214-20081107-00492, filed by Filkonek Corporation

Dear International Bureau Staff,

By this letter, I Alexander Hawak, officer of Filkonek Corporation ("Filkonek"), respectfully request the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to withdraw Filkonek's pending 214 application filed on November 4, 2008 and designated with file ITC-214-20081107-00492 (the "Application.") For commercial reasons, Filkonek is in the process of dissolving as a corporate entity. Therefore, FCC 214 authority is no longer necessary.

In addition, I respectfully take this opportunity to address some issues raised in a Petition to Deny filed on December 3, 2008 by Telwise Corporation ("Telwise.")

Jose Mallari, Vice President of Operations for Telwise, allowed Filkonek, thorough a verbal agreement to use Telwise's business address to receive mail for the purpose of setting up a U.S.-based business. Telwise's address is 73 Radford Street, Yonkers, NY 10705. Telwise later revoked its offer to use its business address and directed Filkonek to stop using Telwise's address. Jose Mallari restated this directive through a declaration in Telwise's Petition to Deny.

As of December 2, 2008, Filkonek has stopped using Telwise's address.
