ITC-214-20081120-00511 (e-file)

UPM Marketing, Inc.'s application for authority to provide facilities-based and resale services between the United States and permissible international points. Applicant is 50% owned by a citizen of Germany.

ITC-T/C-20081124-00512 (e-file)

Application seeking Commission consent to transfer control of PCCW Limited's ("PCCW") wholly-owned indirect subsidiaries BtN Access Limited ("BtN"), PCCW Global, Inc. ("PGI"), and PCCW Global Limited ("PGL"), and the international section 214 authorizations under which they operate, from PCCW to Pacific Century Regional Developments Limited ("PCRD"). PCRD, a Singapore corporation, will hold directly approximately 22.68% and indirectly approximately 38.83% (via Starvest Ltd) of the ownership interests of PCCW Limited. Pacific Century Group (Cayman Islands) Limited will hold directly approximately 37.50 percent and indirectly approximately 37.76 percent (via Anglang Investments Limited) of the ownership interests of Pacific Century Regional Developments Limited. Pacific Century Group (Cayman Islands) Limited is 100% indirectly owned by OS Holdings Limited, a Bermuda corporation. China Netcom Corporation (BVD) Limited will hold directly 33.29 percent of the ownership interests of PCCW Limited. **The people's Republic of China** indirectly owns 100% of China Netcom Corporation (BVD) Limited.
