Dear Sirs,

The Department of Justice (DoJ), including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, with the concurrence of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (collectively, the "Agencies") requested by letter on May 9, 2014, that the FCC terminate, declare null and void and no longer in effect, the current authorization issued under file number ITC-214-20081201-00519 to ACT Telecommunications Inc. ("ACT"). The Agencies allege that ACT has failed to comply with its commitments and undertakings made with the Agencies, and compliance with which are a condition to the authorization issued to ACT by the Commission. The Agencies further state that they have been unable to communicate with ACT for over a year in an effort to resolve this matter.

The International Bureau previously afforded ACT an opportunity to respond to the Agencies' letter by a letter dated May 14, 2014³ and also a Public Notice issued on June 27, 2014.⁴ To date, ACT has failed to respond. Attached is a copy of a second Public Notice issued by the International Bureau providing ACT a final opportunity to respond prior to Commission
