Per the guidance provided by the Policy Division of the FCC International Bureau, this letter is being utilized instead of the discontinuance procedures set forth in Section 63.19 of the Commissions rules,

Arween International Inc. does not provide telecommunications services to retail customers. It has sales to wholesale carriers that make purchases on an ad-hoc basis. As such, this letter will be filed electronically via the FCC IBFS system.

Arween International Inc. does not have discontinuance issues and it has received a status of Green light from the FCC Accounts Receivable since it has resolved all outstanding FCC regulatory fees.

The surrender of the international section 214 authorization of **Arween International Inc.** is to be effective immediately.

Petition to Discontinue Service and Waiver for Notice

Arween International Inc. ("Arween") hereby requests, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and pursuant to the Commissions Rules, Section 63.71 of the Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.), to discontinue service and for the Commission to cancel its international FCC 214 Authorization. Arween operates as an international telecommunications services reseller using the FCC 214 authorization it obtained in 2009. It now seeks Commission approval to surrender its FCC 214 Authorization since it must cease operating due to financial hardship.

Arween is a company incorporated under the laws of the State of New York and it has its offices in New Jersey where it obtained a Certificate of Foreign Authority to operate as a Foreign Corporation. In support of the request of Arween, for authorization to discontinue service, the following information is submitted pursuant to the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.71.

2. Date of planned service discontinuance:
It will cease operations upon receiving Commission approval
3. Points of geographic areas of service affected:
Arween offers interconnected VoIP wholesale international to international traffic routes
4. Brief description of the type of service affected:
Interconnected VoIP wholesale interconnected international to international traffic routes


5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers:
Arween does not have retail customers. In terms of the wholesale carrier customers that it does have, some make purchases on an ad-hoc basis. For such wholesale ad-hoc customers, Arween will be able to simply notify them that it is no longer selling traffic routes. In cases where Arween has agreements with wholesale carriers, it will provide notification via email and execute termination of services pursuant to the exit terms listed under its contract with the respective carrier customer. This will be executed upon receiving Commission approval.

6. Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the service being discontinued:
Arween is a non-dominant carrier that provides Wholesale int'l to int'l traffic routes.

7. Service:
In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules, Arween International Inc. has mailed a copy of this application to the Governors of the affected states (the State of New York and the State of New Jersey), to the affected State public utility commissions (the New York Public Service Commission and New Jersey Board of Public Utilities) and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of the Defense. Please note that Arween International Inc. has never provided telecommunications services to any government agencies or government contractors. It is only sending a copy of this application to the Secretary of Defense since it is statutorily required to do so.

8. Circumstances of Discontinuance
Arween is experiencing financial hardship, so it decided to surrender its FCC 214 authorization and to cease operations upon receiving Commission.

9. Conclusion
Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U. S. C. Section 214, and the commission's Rules regarding 47 C. R. R. Section 6-3.71, Arween understands that this application will be automatically granted on the 31st day after the Public Notice is released, with no Commission notification to Arween, unless the Commission has notified the company that the grant will not be automatically effective.
