Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC (“Charter Fiberlink”), through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the above-referenced Application be amended to include the following information.

On March 27, 2009, Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”) and all of its subsidiaries filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. The Chapter 11 cases are being jointly administered under the caption *In re Charter Communications, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 09-11435. As a result of the bankruptcy filings, Charter now operates as Charter Communications, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession and each of Charter’s subsidiaries, including Charter Fiberlink, has been accorded debtor-in-possession status. Charter and Charter Fiberlink will continue to operate their businesses and manage their properties as debtors-in-possession under the jurisdiction of the Bankruptcy Court.
