
Our records indicate that your international section 214 application (File No. ITC-214-20090429-00183) remains pending at the Commission awaiting completion of review by the Executive Branch. We forwarded the application to the Executive Branch agencies on April 30, 2009. On May 21, 2009, the Commission notified you that your application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review.¹

We understand that you have been contacted by the Executive Branch requesting information about your application and you should have provided to them all necessary and requested information. On October 12, 2010, the Commission requested Newcom, Inc. notify the Commission the status of the pending application and confirm whether the applicant continues to seek Commission action on the application.² You did not respond to that inquiry.
