9. Talton Communications, Inc. (“Talton”) attests to its qualification for streamlined processing under 63.12 as follows:

- a) Talton is not a foreign carrier, nor does it control a foreign carrier as defined in Section 63.09(d), in any destination market.
- b) No two or more foreign carriers, or parties that control foreign carriers, own more than 25% of Talton or are parties to or beneficiaries of a contractual relation affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.
- c) Talton has no affiliation with a dominant US carrier whose international switched or private line services which Talton seeks authority to resell.

10. Talton seeks authority to provide switched services over private lines pursuant to 63.16 as follows:

Talton will only provide switched services over its authorized private lines if the country at the foreign end of the private line appears on the Commission list of destinations to which the Commission has authorized the provision of switched services over private lines. Talton does not seek to add a foreign market to the Commission’s list at this time.
