Telax Voice Solutions, Inc. ("Telax"), by counsel, hereby surrenders its International Section 214 Authorization granted in IB File No. ITC-214-20100331-00137 ("International 214 Authority") effective immediately.

Telax believes surrender of its International 214 Authority is in the public interest because Telax does not provide a service that requires Section 214 authority and because surrendering its International 214 Authority will allow the Commission to concentrate its resources on carriers that require 214 authorization and oversight. Therefore, Telax respectfully submits that the surrender of its International 214 Authorization is reasonable and will not harm the public interest.
