Dear Ms. De La Torre,

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint")<sup>1</sup> hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") that it agrees to accept the terms and conditions for a waiver of the benchmark rate applicable to Cuba specified in the Commission's April 8, 2011 *TeleCuba Waiver Order*, <sup>2</sup> as revised by the Commission's *International Settlements Policy Reform Order*. In support of its notification, Sprint submits the enclosed certification.

Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission, consistent with the process set forth in Paragraph 33 of the *TeleCuba Waiver Order*, reflect Sprint's acceptance of the terms and conditions therein and extend the waiver to it in an "Informative" as part of the Commission's Public Notice of actions taken on international telecommunications applications.<sup>4</sup>
