9. Combined Public Communications, Inc. (“CPC”) attests to its qualification for streamlined processing under 63.12 as follows:

- a) CPC is not a foreign carrier, nor does it control a foreign carrier as defined in Section 63.09(d), in any destination market.
- b) No two or more foreign carriers, or parties that control foreign carriers, own more than 25% of CPC or are parties to or beneficiaries of a contractual relation affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.
- c) CPC has no affiliation with a dominant US carrier whose international switched or private line services CPC seeks authority to resell.

10. CPC seeks authority to provide switched services over private lines pursuant to 63.16 as follows:

CPC will only provide switched services over its authorized private lines if the country at the foreign end of the private line appears on the Commission list of destinations to which the Commission has authorized the provision of switched services over private lines. CPC does not seek to add a foreign market to the Commission’s list at this time.
