Re: Surrender of International Section 214 Authorizations

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of MetroNet Systems Holdings, LLC ("MetroNet Systems") and its indirect subsidiaries Climax Telephone LLC ("Climax"), CMN-RUS, LLC ("CMN-RUS"), Jaguar Communications, LLC ("Jaguar"), Metro Fibernet, LLC ("MFN") and Vexus Fiber, LLC ("Vexus") (collectively, "Metronet Licensees"), this letter surrenders the international Section 214 authorizations of the Metronet Licensees. The Metronet Licensees no longer provide international common carrier telecommunications services to any customers.¹ Accordingly, the surrender of authorizations is effective upon filing of this letter with the Commission in the dockets noted below.

Each Metronet Licensee holds an international Section 214 authorization to provide global or limited global resale services as follows: (1) MetroNet Systems holds File No. ITC-214-20110114-00005; (2) Climax holds File No. ITC-214-20110314-00072; (3) Jaguar holds File No. ITC-214-20010125-00060; and (4) Vexus holds File No. ITC-214-19971024-00657. MetroNet Systems indirect subsidiaries CMN-RUS, LLC and Metro Fibernet, LLC operate under the international Section 214 authorization of MetroNet Systems.

MetroNet Systems and its subsidiaries have a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") dated May 9, 2025, with the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Services Sector, U.S. Department of Justice and U.S. Department of Homeland Security (collectively, the "Compliance Monitoring Agencies" or "CMAs"). Compliance with the LOA was a condition of approval of transactions described in FCC File

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Nos. ITC-ASG-20240808-00133, ITC-T/C-20240808-00130, ITC-T/C-20240808-00131, ITC-T/C-20240808-00132 and WC Docket No. 24-244 (TT 24-044 to -48). Given that the Metronet Licensees no longer provide international common carrier telecommunications services nor hold international Section 214 authorizations as a result of this filing, MetroNet Systems will request that the CMAs submit a letter to the Commission confirming termination of the LOA.
