SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Kingstone Telecommunications, Inc. ("Kingstone" or "Applicant") hereby seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Sections 63.71 and 63.19 of the Federal Communication Commission's ("FCC") Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71 and 63.19, to surrender its Domestic and International 214 Authority.

2) Date of Planned Service Discontinuance

Kingstone has no customers at the date of this Application and authorization of the discontinuance pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 5 63.71(c).

3) Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected

Applicant is no longer providing telecommunications services within the continental United States, Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico and the US. Virgin Islands.

4) Brief description of type of service affected

Kingstone requests surrender all regulated telecommunications services in the United States.

5) Regulatory Classification of Carrier

Kingstone is considered non-dominant with respect to the affected telecommunications services.

Conclusion

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of these services since there are alternative providers of these services, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission approve its Section 63.71 Application.

Kingstone submits this application with the understanding that under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(c) a standard application seeking authority for the discontinuance, reduction, or impairment of telecommunications service will be granted automatically on the 31st day after the Commission releases public notice of the application, unless the Commission notifies the Applicant that the application will not be automatically granted.

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
