Response to Question 14:

Cordova Long Distance, Inc. ("CLD") is a wholly owned subsidiary of Cordova Telephone Cooperative, Inc. There are no other persons or entities with ten percent or greater direct or indirect equity interests in CLD. Cordova Telephone Cooperative is a member-owned cooperative formed under Alaska Statutes Title 10, Chapter 25 as is principally engaged in the business of providing local exchange telecommunications services in Cordova, Alaska. Its address is 611 Second Street, P.O. Box 459, Cordova, Alaska 99547.

CLD has common directors with Cordova Telephone Cooperative, Inc., and with Cordova Wireless Communications, Inc., neither of which is a foreign carrier.
