The Departments of Justice, Homeland Security, and Defense (collectively, the Agencies), write to inform the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that the Agencies are no longer reviewing the above-captioned application for national security and law enforcement concerns.

On June 15, 2020, counsel for CITIC Telecom International CPC (USA) LLC informed the Agencies that it no longer wished to continue proceeding with its application, and subsequently filed a letter with the FCC requesting withdrawal of the application without prejudice. In light of the Applicant's withdrawal, the Agencies ceased their review.
