Response to Question 9:

This application qualifies for streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 63.12, for the following reasons:

- Alestra, S. de R.L. de C.V. ("Applicant") is affiliated with a foreign carrier in Mexico; however, Mexico is a WTO Member Country and Applicant qualifies for a presumption of non-dominance, as it has far less than 50 percent market share in Mexico.
- Applicant is not affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services Applicant seeks authority to resell.

Response to Question 11:

Applicant provides the following information and certifications as required by Section 63.18(i) through (m) of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 63.18(i)-(m):

- (i) Applicant certifies that it is a foreign carrier in Mexico.
- (j) Applicant certifies that it seeks to provide international telecommunications services to Mexico – a destination country in which Applicant is a foreign carrier.
- (k) Mexico is a WTO Member Country.
- (l) Applicant qualifies for a presumption of non-dominance, because it has less than 50 percent market share in Mexico.
- (m) Applicant qualifies for a presumption of non-dominance, because it has less than 50 percent market share in Mexico.
