**Re: Voiamo US, Inc., Voluntary Surrender of International Section 214  
Authorization, IBFS File No. ITC-214-20120821-00208**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Please accept this letter as Voiamo US, Inc. hereby notifying the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) that it has discontinued the provision of international services and surrenders its international Section 214 authorization, issued under File No. ITC-214-20120821-00208, effective immediately. Voiamo US, Inc. was granted its Section 214 authorization subject to commitments and assurances provided to the Department of Justice, and is a signatory to a Letter of Agreement (LOA), signed November 14, 2012.

As part of bankruptcy proceedings concluded in November 2016, Voiamo Group PLC (a United Kingdom-based holding company and the parent of Voiamo US, Inc) sold off the majority of its business assets including the Globalgig brand to iGEM Communications LLC. Voiamo US, Inc. was not part of the asset sale and became unviable and was closed down. The Section 214 license issued to Voiamo US, Inc., was not part of the asset sale and remains active in the name of Voiamo US, Inc., based on a mistaken assumption that the license would automatically cancel when the company ceased to operate.

I left my position as company director at Voiamo US, Inc in November 2016 and I am now the Chief Revenue Officer at Globalgig Limited, UK. Voiamo US, Inc. has remained in bankruptcy since November 2016 and therefore does not currently provide international telecommunications services to any customers pursuant to the Section 214 authorization, and the company is therefore not required to provide notice of discontinuance pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19.

We have notified the Department of Justice that Voiamo US, Inc does not provide services subject to the LOA, and that it had no continuing use of the license at the time the company was wound down in the bankruptcy proceeding.
