Dear Mr. Sankar and Ms. Vashishth:

Our records indicate that the international Section 214 application for Telecommunications Services Network LLC (TSN), File No. ITC-214-20131017-00275, remains pending at the Commission awaiting completion of review by the Executive Branch agencies. On October 30, 2013, we forwarded the application to the Executive Branch agencies. On November 22, 2013, the Commission notified you that, pursuant to Section 63.12(c)(3) of the Commission's rules, your application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review and that TSN could not commence operations until the authorization is granted. The Executive Branch agencies have informed us that there have been no discussions between the agencies and you or your counsel regarding their review of the application in a significant period of time.

Please inform us no later than **Friday**, **November 27**, **2015**, if you would like to continue to seek the grant of the international Section 214 application for TSN. Your response should be submitted in the file – ITC-214-20131017-00275 – via IBFS, and you should email a copy to me at <u>Denise.Coca@fcc.gov</u>.³ Failure to respond to this information request will subject your application to dismissal without prejudice under Sections 1.748(a) and 63.51(b) of the Commission's rules.⁴
