Dear Ms. Dortch:

iTellum Ltd. and Telediga Ltd. hereby notify the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of their intent to discontinue the provision of international services and surrender its international Section 214 authorization, issued under File Nos. ITC-214-20131121-00317 and ITC-214-20131121-00319, effective immediately. iTellum Ltd. and Telediga Ltd. were granted their Section 214 authorizations subject to commitments and assurances provided to the Department of Justice, and are signatories to a Letter of Agreement (LOA), signed June 16 2014.

iTellum Ltd. and Telediga Ltd. do not currently provide international telecommunications services to any customers pursuant to the Section 214 authorization, and the companies are therefore not required to provide notice of discontinuance pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19.

We have notified the Department of Justice that we do not provide services subject to the LOA, and that we intend to surrender the authorization.
