Response to item 14:

- (e) Arthur N. Abbey, a United States citizen whose address is c/o Cellular Properties, Inc., PO Box 120598, Nashville, TN 37212-0598, owns and votes a 1.98% stock interest in Applicant.

Jonathan and Leslie Abbey are brother and sister. Arthur N. Abbey is the father of Jonathan and Leslie Abbey. All serve as officers of Applicant. The principal business of all is telecommunications.
