The Applicant does qualify for streamlined processing because it is not a foreign carrier and it does not control a foreign carrier. Snail Mobile, LLC is a California limited liability company. It is 100% owned by its sole member, Mr. Shi Hai, a Chinese citizen. Snail Mobile, LLC does not control a foreign carrier in any country. Snail Mobile's sole member, Shi Hai, holds a 58.35% equity interest in Suzhou Snail Digital Technology Co., Ltd. ("Snail Digital"), which is a Chinese corporation that provides MVNO services and develops online video games.

Not Applicable. Applicant does not seek authority to provide switched services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched services over private lines.

business is in Suzhou, China, and Snail Digital also owns 100% of Snail Games USA, Inc., a California online video gaming corporation.
