The Applicant does qualify for streamlined processing because it is not a foreign carrier and it does not control a foreign carrier in China. Applicant is owned 100% by Dr Peng Telecom & Media Group Corp. ("Dr Peng") from China. Dr Peng controls 5% share of the broadband internet market in China. Dr Peng currently has no cellular facilities or services.

Dr Peng is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange with the trading code 600804; Dr Peng's top ten (10) shareholders are as follows:

Top 10 shareholders control 27.05% of Dr Peng with only one shareholder controlling over 5% of the Applicant's parent.
