On behalf of iFAX Solutions, Inc. d/b/a T38Fax.com ("iFAX") I submit this letter as a formal request for withdrawal of iFAX's Application for International 214 Authority. On April 22, 2015 iFAX applied for authority from the Federal Communications Commission ("the Commission") pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 <u>et</u>. <u>Al</u>. (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global or limited international resale services ("the Application). To date, the Application has been forwarded to the Executive Branch for review due to iFAX's foreign ownership.

Subsequent to iFAX filing the Application, iFAX retained undersigned counsel, who in the course of reviewing iFAX's services, determined that the service would not necessitate procurement of international 214 authority.

In conclusion, iFAX respectfully requests withdrawal of the Application, and has given notice to the Executive Branch as to its intention to withdraw the Application.
