Dear Mr. Souza:

Our records indicate that the application filed by Skillnet Telecom Service Corp. (Skillnet) for an international Section 214 authorization, File No. ITC-214-20150727-00186, remains pending at the Commission awaiting completion of review by the Executive Branch agencies. On August 6, 2015, we forwarded the application to the Executive Branch agencies. On August 28, 2015, the Commission notified you that, pursuant to Section 63.12(c)(3) of the Commission's rules,<sup>1</sup> your application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review and that Skillnet could not commence operations until the authorization is granted.<sup>2</sup>

On December 7, 2015, the Executive Branch agencies have informed us that they have not received a response to supplemental questions that were sent to your counsel, Mr. Maldonado, on November 5, 2015 with a due date of November 16, 2015. According to the Executive Branch agencies, no response was received and a follow-up email was sent on November 25, 2015 with a new deadline of November 27, 2015. The Executive Branch agencies indicate that no response was received. Consequently, the Executive Branch agencies cannot conduct their review of the application and request dismissal of the application.

Please inform us no later than **Monday, January 11, 2016**, if you would like to continue to seek the grant of the international Section 214 application for Skillnet. Your response should be submitted in the file – ITC-214-20150727-00186 – via IBFS. In addition, please email a copy
