Dear Ms. Dortch:

Moxtel Inc. hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of its intent to discontinue the provision of international services and surrender its international Section 214 authorization, issued under File No. ITC-214-20151218-00306, effective immediately. Moxtel Inc. was granted its Section 214 authorization subject to commitments and assurances provided to the Department of Justice, and is a signatory to a Letter of Agreement (LOA), signed January 6, 2017.

Moxtel Inc. does not currently provide international telecommunications services to any customers pursuant to the Section 214 authorization, and the company is therefore not required to provide notice of discontinuance pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19.

We have notified the Department of Justice that we do not provide services subject to the LOA, and that we intend to surrender the authorization.
