

After discussions with representatives of the Applicant in connection with the above-referenced proceedings, DOJ has concluded that additional commitments set forth in the Agreement will help ensure that the agency responsible for enforcing the law, protecting national security, and preserving public safety, can proceed appropriately to satisfy those responsibilities. Accordingly, DOJ advises the Commission that it has no objection to the Commission granting the application in the above-referenced proceedings, provided that the Commission conditions its consent on the compliance by Bharti with the Agreement.
