Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Departments of Justice, Homeland Security, and Defense (collectively, the Agencies), write to inform the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that the Agencies are no longer reviewing the above-captioned application (Application) for national security and law enforcement concerns.

After multiple attempts, the Agencies have been unable to contact Platcomm Corp. (the Applicant). On June 12, 2020, the Applicant's former counsel advised that he attempted to contact the Applicant via electronic mail and received only an automated response that his message could not be delivered. On June 17, 2020, the Agencies attempted to reach the Applicant by telephone, using the telephone number listed in the Application, and discovered that the telephone number is now associated with a different company. The Applicant's former counsel was unable to provide any additional contact information for the Applicant.

Accordingly, the Agencies return this application to the FCC for further review under its rules and regulations.
