RE: Potential Dismissal of Alleswolke Wireless LLC's Application for International Section 214 Authority, File No. ITC-214-20180515-00097

Dear Mr. Li and Mr. Mou:

On May 15, 2018, Alleswolke Wireless LLC (Alleswolke) filed the above referenced application with the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) for an international section 214 authorization, File No. ITC-214-20180515-00097. On August 31, 2018, the Commission referred Alleswolke's application to the Department of Justice, the Department of Defense, and the Department of Homeland Security (collectively the "Executive Branch agencies") due to the applicant's reportable foreign ownership. On September 5, 2018, the Executive Branch agencies requested that the Commission defer action on the application while they reviewed it for any national security, law enforcement, and public safety concerns.¹ Alleswolke has a delinquent debt and must submit payment within thirty days of this notice or we will dismiss the application without prejudice.

Section 1.1910(a)(1) of the Commission's rules requires the Commission to examine each application to determine whether the applicant is delinquent in any non-tax debt owed to the Commission.² Section 1.1910(b)(2) of the Commission's rules requires the Commission to withhold action on applications, including requests for authorization by any entity found to be delinquent in its debt to the Commission.³ Section 1.1910(b)(3) of the Commission's rules states that "[i]f a delinquency has not been paid or the debtor has not made other satisfactory arrangements within 30 days of the date

of the notice provided pursuant to paragraph (b)(2) of this section, the application or request for authorization will be dismissed.”⁴

We request that Alleswolke submit the payment within 30 days, by December 26, 2019. If payment is not made, we will dismiss the application without prejudice pursuant to Section 1.1910(b)(3) of the Commission’s rules.⁵ Please visit the Red Light Display System’s website for information on this debt and how to pay it.⁶ We look forward to your prompt attention to this matter.
