On behalf of Internap Connectivity, LLC ("<u>INAP Connectivity</u>"), this letter surrenders, effective immediately, the International Section 214 Authorization of INAP Connectivity granted in IB File No. ITC-214-20190715-00132 (the "<u>International 214 Authority</u>").

INAP Connectivity does not currently provide international common carrier services that require authorization from the Commission pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934. Therefore, because the International 214 Authority is not necessary, INAP Connectivity's surrender of the International 214 Authority is reasonable and will not harm the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity. Additionally, because INAP Connectivity does not provide international common carrier services to any customers, INAP Connectivity is not subject to the customer notification requirements of Section 63.19 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19.
