As part of the Commission's public interest analysis, the Commission considers whether such an application raises national security, law enforcement, foreign policy, or trade policy

LOA will help ensure that USDOJ can proceed appropriately in satisfying its responsibilities to
enforce the law, protect national security, and preserve public safety. Accordingly, USDOJ
advises the Commission that it has no objection to the Commission granting the application in
the above- referenced proceedings, provided that the Commission conditions its consent on
compliance with the LOA.
