APPLICATION

I. Introduction

ConnX Inc. ("ConnX") respectfully requests global resale authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (the "Act"), Sections 63.12 and 63.18 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission" or "FCC")¹. ConnX requests streamlined processing.

II. Description of the Applicant

ConnX provides integrated communication as a service platform provider for secure network connectivity, unified communications, collaboration and digital first contact centers. Its mission is to accelerate business digital transformation by simplifying connectivity, collaboration and service assurance operations. ConnX is a U.S. company based in New Jersey, with U.S. ownership, and has been in business since 2015. It currently manages more than 10,000 customer sites, including more than 100 Fortune 500 companies.

ConnX has determined that obtaining Section 214 authority to offer global resale services will enhance its ability to meeting customer needs. In particular, obtaining Section 214 authority will allow ConnX to provide bundles of services that will permit its customers to obtain more of their communications services from ConnX as a one-stop provider.

III. Public Interest Statement

This application requests Commission authorization for ConnX to offer global resale services. Grant of the application will permit ConnX to extend the options available to its customers in the evolving environment of hyperconnected businesses that operate and collaborate across national boundaries. Services like those offered by ConnX have become increasingly important since the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic and the inclusion of services covered by this application will help ConnX meet the broader needs of customers operating their businesses remotely around the globe.

IV. Request for Streamlined Processing

ConnX respectfully submits that this application should be granted streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules.²

This application is eligible for streamlined processing because ConnX is not affiliated with a foreign carrier in any destination market or with a dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services it seeks authority to resell. Thus, none of the exclusionary criteria in Section 63.12(c) will apply to this application. Moreover, Applicant is not affiliated with any dominant foreign carrier.

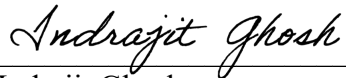
