The Applicant, Global Power Telecom Group, LLC, is not a foreign government, a representative of a foreign government, or an entity subject to the direction or control of any foreign government. The Applicant is a privately held domestic limited liability company wholly owned by a United States citizen, as further detailed in Section 4 of this Application.

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SECTION 2 — DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED INTERNATIONAL SERVICES

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.18(b)–(e)

2.1 Overview of Authority Sought

Global Power Telecom Group, LLC hereby applies to the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) for authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and the Commission’s

implementing rules at 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to provide international telecommunications services between the United States and all international points worldwide. Specifically, the Applicant seeks the following categories of authority:

(1) Global Resale of International Switched Services	47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(1)	Authority to resell international switched telecommunications services on all international routes between the United States and all international points.
(2) Global Resale of International Private Line Services	47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(2)	Authority to resell international private line telecommunications services on all international routes between the United States and all international points.
(3) Global Authority — All International Routes	47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(3)	Global authority covering all international routes and all countries and territories worldwide, without restriction to specific routes.

2.2 Description of Service Types

2.2.1 Resale of International Switched Services

The Applicant proposes to provide international switched telecommunications services to customers in the United States and internationally by reselling the services of authorized U.S. carriers and their foreign correspondents. Such services shall include, without limitation, voice telephony services, data communications services, and other switched traffic transmitted via the public switched telephone network (“PSTN”) and Internet Protocol (“IP”)-based networks, including Voice over Internet Protocol (“VoIP”) services provided on a common carrier basis. All switched services shall be carried pursuant to carrier agreements with authorized U.S. and foreign carriers holding the requisite international authorizations.

2.2.2 Resale of International Private Line Services

The Applicant further proposes to provide international private line telecommunications services by leasing and reselling dedicated international circuits obtained from authorized

U.S. carriers and, where applicable, their foreign correspondent carriers. Such private line services shall include dedicated point-to-point international transmission capacity and associated services. The Applicant will obtain all necessary underlying capacity from carriers holding valid international authorizations and will resell such capacity to its customers in compliance with Commission rules, including the applicable accounting rate and settlement rules.

2.3 Facilities and Transmission

The Applicant does not propose to acquire, own, or operate any international transmission facilities in connection with this application. All international telecommunications services to be provided by Global Power Telecom Group, LLC will be furnished on a pure resale basis, utilizing the transmission facilities and network infrastructure of authorized U.S. carriers and their international correspondent carriers. No undersea cable, satellite, or other international transmission facility ownership or operation is contemplated by this application.

IBFS Note — Facilities Type:

This application is limited strictly to resale authority. No facilities-based international authority is sought herein. Applicant does not hold, and does not seek herein, any license, permit, or authorization related to international submarine cable systems, earth station facilities, or any other transmission infrastructure.

2.4 Geographic Scope

The Applicant seeks international Section 214 authority on a **global basis**, encompassing all international telecommunications routes between the United States and all foreign points, including all countries and territories worldwide. No limitation to specific routes, countries, or regions is intended, and the Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission grant

authority without restriction to particular international routes, consistent with the Commission's practice for resale-only applicants not affiliated with foreign carriers.

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SECTION 3 — STREAMLINED PROCESSING ELIGIBILITY STATEMENT

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.12

3.1 Eligibility Grounds

Global Power Telecom Group, LLC respectfully submits that this Application is eligible for streamlined processing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. The Applicant satisfies all criteria for streamlined treatment on the following grounds:

1. **No Foreign Carrier Ownership:** No foreign carrier, as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 63.09(d), holds, directly or indirectly, a 10% or greater ownership interest in the Applicant, and the Applicant is not affiliated with any foreign carrier within the meaning of Commission rules.
2. **No Foreign Government Ownership:** No foreign government, instrumentality of a foreign government, or entity controlled by a foreign government holds any ownership interest, financial interest, or control in the Applicant, whether directly or indirectly.
3. **No Non-U.S. Citizen Ownership:** No non-U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien holds, directly or indirectly, a 10% or greater ownership interest in the Applicant. The Applicant is wholly owned by a United States citizen, as set forth in Section 4 of this Application.

4. **No Foreign Carrier Affiliation:** The Applicant is not affiliated with any foreign carrier within the meaning of 47 C.F.R. § 63.09(d). There are no interlocking ownership, management, or control relationships between the Applicant and any foreign carrier or foreign government entity.
5. **Resale-Only Authority:** All services proposed to be provided by the Applicant will be furnished exclusively on a resale basis, utilizing the transmission facilities of authorized U.S. carriers and their international correspondents. No international transmission facilities are owned, operated, or proposed to be acquired by the Applicant.

3.2 Deemed-Granted Treatment

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.12(c), an application that qualifies for streamlined processing shall be deemed granted on the 14th day following public notice of the application by the Commission, unless the Commission notifies the Applicant prior to that date that the application has been designated for further consideration or removed from streamlined processing. The Applicant submits that this Application satisfies all requirements for streamlined processing and deemed-granted treatment under the Commission's rules.

The Applicant is not aware of any reason why this Application should not be processed on a streamlined basis. No issues of foreign ownership, foreign carrier affiliation, national security, law enforcement, or foreign policy are presented herein that would require additional review or consideration by the Commission or relevant Executive Branch agencies.

Regulatory Basis for Streamlined Processing:

47 C.F.R.

§

63.12 — Streamlined processing and deemed-granted treatment apply where no foreign carrier affiliation exists, all services are to be provided on a resale basis, and no foreign or non-U.S. citizen ownership interest of 10% or greater is held. The Applicant hereby confirms satisfaction of all criteria set forth therein.

Accordingly, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission process this Application on an expedited, streamlined basis pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.12, and that this Application be deemed granted 14 days following public notice absent further action by the Commission.

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SECTION 4 — OWNERSHIP NARRATIVE AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(h)

4.1 Ownership Narrative

Global Power Telecom Group, LLC is a Florida limited liability company that is wholly and exclusively owned by **Keren-Esther Hoskins**, a natural person and a citizen of the United States of America. Ms. Hoskins holds **100%** of all outstanding equity interests and 100% of all voting interests in Global Power Telecom Group, LLC, directly and without the interposition of any intermediate holding company, trust, parent entity, or nominee arrangement.

There are no intermediate holding companies, parent corporations, affiliated entities, or upstream owners of any kind interposed between Ms. Hoskins and Global Power Telecom

Group, LLC. The organizational structure of the Applicant is wholly domestic and uncomplicated, consisting solely of the single-member limited liability company and its sole member and owner.

No foreign individual, entity, corporation, partnership, association, joint venture, foreign government, instrumentality of a foreign government, or any other foreign person or organization holds, directly or indirectly, any ownership interest, equity interest, membership interest, voting interest, financial interest, or right of control in Global Power Telecom Group, LLC.

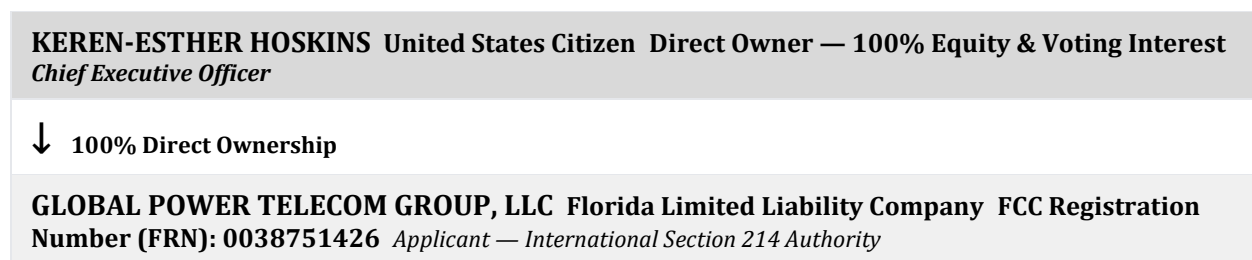


Figure 1: Complete Ownership and Control Structure of Global Power Telecom Group, LLC

4.3 Alien Ownership Confirmation

As required by 47 U.S.C. § 310(b), the Applicant hereby confirms and affirmatively represents that:

6. No alien, foreign government, or corporation organized under the laws of a foreign country holds a direct ownership interest, indirect ownership interest, or any right of control in Global Power Telecom Group, LLC;

7. No alien, foreign government, or foreign-organized entity holds, directly or indirectly, more than 20% of the capital stock or membership interests in Global Power Telecom Group, LLC;
8. Global Power Telecom Group, LLC is not organized under the laws of any foreign government and is not subject to the direction or control of any foreign government or foreign corporation; and
9. No officer, director, member, or controlling person of Global Power Telecom Group, LLC is an alien or foreign national who is not a lawful permanent resident or citizen of the United States.

The Applicant's ownership structure fully complies with the alien ownership restrictions set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 310(b) and all applicable FCC rules promulgated thereunder.

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SECTION 5 — QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANT

5.1 Technical, Managerial, and Financial Qualifications

Global Power Telecom Group, LLC possesses the technical, managerial, and financial qualifications necessary and sufficient to provide international telecommunications services in full compliance with all applicable FCC regulations, the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and applicable international telecommunications standards and obligations. The Applicant is prepared to commence operations promptly upon grant of the requested international Section 214 authority and is committed to sustaining compliant, reliable, and high-quality service to its customers on an ongoing basis.

The Applicant's management team brings substantial expertise in telecommunications service delivery, regulatory compliance, information security, and business operations. The

company has developed internal policies, procedures, and operational frameworks designed to ensure compliance with all relevant FCC rules, domestic legal requirements, and applicable international standards governing the provision of international telecommunications services.

With respect to financial qualifications, the Applicant is financially prepared to meet its obligations as an authorized international telecommunications carrier, including compliance costs, regulatory fees, and all other obligations attendant to the provision of international telecommunications services. As a resale-only carrier not proposing to own or operate any international transmission facilities, the Applicant's capital expenditure requirements are limited, and its financial position is commensurate with the scope of the proposed services.

5.2 Leadership Qualifications

Keren-Esther Hoskins, Chief Executive Officer and sole member of Global Power Telecom Group, LLC, brings to the company a distinguished professional background and advanced credentials in cybersecurity, network defense, and information assurance that are directly relevant to the secure and reliable provision of international telecommunications services. Ms. Hoskins is a certified Cybersecurity Professional with extensive credentials encompassing network defense architecture, penetration testing methodologies, and comprehensive information assurance frameworks. Her professional qualifications include advanced training in cybersecurity frameworks consistent with federal and international telecommunications security standards, including those applied by the National Institute of Standards and Technology ("NIST"), the Department of Homeland Security ("DHS"), and international counterpart agencies.

Ms. Hoskins' expertise in secure network architecture and threat-mitigation strategies positions Global Power Telecom Group, LLC to operate a compliant, secure, and resilient international telecommunications service offering. Her background directly supports the company's ability to implement and maintain robust cybersecurity protocols, network security measures, and information assurance practices that meet or exceed the standards applicable to international telecommunications carriers operating under FCC authorization.

These qualifications are especially pertinent in view of the heightened emphasis by the Commission and federal security agencies on the cybersecurity posture of telecommunications carriers authorized to provide international services.

5.3 Regulatory Compliance Commitment

Global Power Telecom Group, LLC is fully committed to complying with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations governing the provision of international telecommunications services. This commitment expressly includes, but is not limited to:

- All rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission applicable to international common carriers, including those set forth in 47 C.F.R. Parts 63 and 64;
- The Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act (“CALEA”), 47 U.S.C. §§ 1001–1010, including all lawful intercept obligations applicable to international telecommunications carriers;
- All applicable national security, law enforcement, and public safety requirements imposed by the Commission, the Department of Justice (“DOJ”), the Federal Bureau of Investigation (“FBI”), the Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), and other relevant federal agencies;
- All applicable international telecommunications obligations arising under treaties, agreements, and arrangements to which the United States is a party;
- All applicable Consumer Protection regulations, including those relating to billing, truth-in-billing, and slamming/cramming prohibitions; and
- All applicable Universal Service Fund (“USF”) contribution obligations, and all FCC reporting and recordkeeping requirements applicable to authorized international carriers.

The Applicant acknowledges its obligation to obtain any necessary Executive Branch review pursuant to applicable national security and law enforcement review procedures, and

commits to cooperate fully with any such review that may be required in connection with this Application or the provision of international telecommunications services thereunder.

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SECTION 6 — REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS AND SIGNATURE

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.18(i), 63.18(n), 63.18(o)

The undersigned, being duly authorized to execute this Application on behalf of Global Power Telecom Group, LLC, hereby makes the following certifications, each of which is made under penalty of law and subject to the verification and accuracy requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 1.17:

Certification 1 — Foreign Carrier Affiliation47 C.F.R. § 63.18(i)

The Applicant, Global Power Telecom Group, LLC, hereby certifies that it is not affiliated with a foreign carrier, as that term is defined in 47 C.F.R. § 63.09(d). Specifically, the Applicant certifies that: (a) no foreign carrier holds any direct or indirect ownership interest of any amount in the Applicant; (b) the Applicant does not control, and does not hold any ownership interest of any amount, in any foreign carrier; and (c) no officer, director, managing member, or person exercising de facto control of the Applicant is also an officer, director, or controlling person of any foreign carrier. The Applicant has no affiliation, relationship, or arrangement with any foreign carrier that would give such foreign carrier the ability to influence or control the actions of the Applicant in any material respect.

Certification 2 — No Special Concessions47 C.F.R. § 63.18(n)

The Applicant hereby certifies that it has not agreed to accept, and will not accept, any special concessions, in violation of 47 C.F.R. § 63.14, directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses market power on the foreign end of the route. For purposes of this certification, the term “special concessions” includes any preferential arrangements, exclusive dealing arrangements, or other terms or conditions that are not available on a nondiscriminatory basis to similarly situated U.S. international carriers. The Applicant is not a party to, and has not sought, any such preferential concession arrangements with any foreign carrier.

Certification 3 — Anti-Drug Abuse Act47 C.F.R. § 63.18(o) — 21 U.S.C. § 862

The Applicant hereby certifies that neither it nor any party to this Application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, codified at 21 U.S.C. § 862, as a result of a conviction for the possession or distribution of a controlled substance. The Applicant further certifies that it has conducted a reasonable inquiry and is not aware of any basis upon which such a denial of federal benefits could be asserted against the Applicant, its members, officers, or directors in connection with this Application.

Certification 4 — Accuracy and Completeness of Application

The Applicant hereby certifies that all statements of fact contained in this Application, and in all exhibits, attachments, and supplemental filings submitted herewith, are true, accurate, and complete to the best of the Applicant’s knowledge and belief, and are made in good faith. The Applicant further certifies that it is familiar with the Commission’s rules regarding

misrepresentation and lack of candor, as set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 1.17, and that nothing in this Application is intended to mislead or deceive the Commission. The Applicant understands that willful false statements in this Application are punishable by fine or imprisonment pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 1001 and may subject the Applicant to denial of the Application or revocation of any authorization granted thereunder.
