

**CERTIFICATE**

The undersigned hereby certifies, on behalf of Simwood, Inc. (“Applicant”) with respect to the foregoing application for authority to provide international services, that:

1. Applicant will comply with the terms and conditions contained in Sections 63.21, 63.22 and 63.23 of the Commission's Rules.
2. Applicant is affiliated with a foreign carrier in the United Kingdom, to which Applicant proposes to provide service in the foregoing application.
3. Applicant seeks to provide international telecommunications service to a destination where: (3) an entity that owns more than a 25% interest in Applicant, or controls Applicant, controls a foreign carrier in that country. As discussed in its response to Question 11, the United Kingdom is a member of the WTO and none of Applicant’s affiliates have “sufficient market power to affect competition adversely in the U.S. market” per 47 CFR § 63.09(f).
4. Applicant has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses sufficient market power on the foreign end of the route to affect competition adversely in the U.S. market and will not enter into such agreements in the future.
5. No party to this application is subject to a denial for Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853(a).
