**Wide Voice, LLC attests to its qualification for streamlined processing under 63.12 as follows:**

- a) Wide Voice, LLC is not a foreign carrier, nor does it control a foreign carrier as defined in Section 63.09(d), in any destination market.
- b) No two or more foreign carriers, or parties that control foreign carriers, own more than 25% of Wide Voice, LLC or are parties to or beneficiaries of a contractual relation affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.
- c) No owner of Wide Voice, LLC controls a foreign carrier in any country.
- d) Wide Voice, LLC has no affiliation with a dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services Wide Voice, LLC seeks authority to resell.
- e) Wide Voice, LLC is not requesting authority to provide switched services over private lines to countries not previously authorized for service by the Commission.

**Wide Voice, LLC responds to 63.18 (d) and (e) as follows:**

- (d) Wide Voice, LLC has not received previous authority under Section 214.
- (e) Wide Voice, LLC requests Section 214 Authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2).
