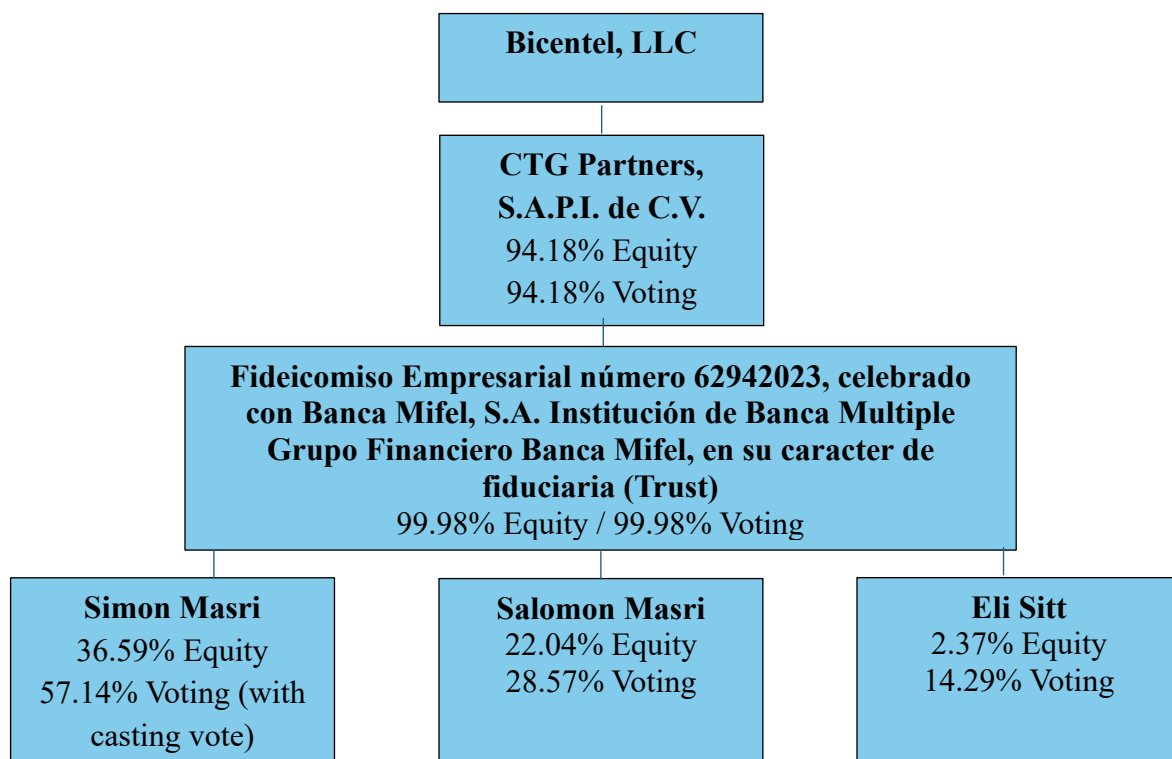

Bicentel is a non-dominant carrier. The Commission previously classified Bicentel as non-dominant pursuant to Section 63.10. See File No. ITC-214-20120718-00175.

Answer to Question 24:

This reorganization will help ensure that Bicentel is fully capitalized. Reorganization will foster Bicentel's uninterrupted service to customers and will maintain competition in the marketplace.

Answer to Question 27:

Bicentel is a non-dominant carrier. The Commission previously classified Bicentel as non-dominant pursuant to Section 63.10. See File No. ITC-214-20120718-00175.

Answer to Question 28:

Prior to the *pro forma* transfer of control, Bicentel, LLC was owned by Simon Masri who held a direct 100% equity and voting interest in the company. Bicentel is filing this notice to inform the Commission of a *pro forma* transfer of control that was completed on September 15, 2025. Post-transfer, Simon Masri holds an indirect interest in Bicentel 57.14% voting (with casting vote) and 36.59% equity. Thus, Simon Masri retains control over Bicentel post-transfer.

The reorganization was structured as a sale of Simon Masri's direct ownership interest in Bicentel to CTG Partners, S.A.P.I. de C.V. (CTG). Post-transaction, CTG holds a direct interest in Bicentel of 94.18% equity and voting. CTG is primarily owned by a Trust (named above), which holds a 99.98% equity and voting interest in CTG. The trust is controlled by three trustees ("Committee"), Simon Masri (its President), Salomon Masri (its Secretary), and Eli Sitt. Simon Masri is entitled to exercise 3 votes as trustee. Salomon Masri is entitled to exercise 2 votes, and Eli Sitt holds 1 vote. Simon Masri also holds a casting vote, which effectively gives him control over the Committee's resolutions. In addition, Simon Masri is the only person with the exclusive right to freely appoint the members of said Committee. He also holds a non-attributable (less than 1%) direct interest in CTG.

Post-transfer, Bicentel continues to hold its international section 214 authorization, and it continues to operate under the name Bicentel.

Answer to Question 29:

The *pro forma* transfer of control described in this application took place on September 15, 2025. The deadline to file this notification fell during the federal government shutdown that began on October 1, 2025. This application is being filed in compliance with the guidance in DA

25-943 stating that filings that were originally due between October 1 and November 17, 2025 are due on November 18, 2025.
