

**AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO THE TRANSFER OF
CONTROL OF SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATION FROM VERISIGN, INC.
TO GLOBALTEL LD, INC.**

Applicants' response to Question No. 13 is revised as follows:

On July 30, 2006, Verisign, Inc. and GlobalTel LD, Inc. executed an asset purchase agreement. Pursuant to that asset purchase agreement, GlobalTel will acquire all of the assets of National Telemanagement Corporation d/b/a American Roaming Network. Those assets include the d/b/a's used by National Telemanagement Corporation in all jurisdictions in which it does business using said d/b/a's, as well as the customer base of National Telemanagement Corporation. Upon grant of this application, the parties will consummate the purchase of said assets. National Telemanagement Corporation will continue to provide the services which it currently offers, but will do so under the ownership of GlobalTel. Pursuant to the Commission's rules, the parties will notify the Commission that the transaction has been consummated.
